• Format:

- Morning: World Record Status WA 720 Qualification Round
- Afternoon: Head-to-Head matches in each division
- This is an ArcheryGB Tier 2 event

Rounds:

- o Adults 70m recurve / 50m Compound / 50m Barebow
- Under 21's 70m Recurve / 50 m Compound
- o Under 18's 60m Recurve / 50m Compound
 - Over 50's and under 21's are welcome to take part but there are separate categories
 - 6 arrow ends in 4 minutes
 - Timing will be controlled by the judges using a Chronotir Timing system
 - All targets will be layered foam

Timings:

- Strictly no access or entry before 07:30 am
- o Registration from 08:00 08:45 am proof of AGB membership will be required
- o Equipment inspection: from 08:00 am in front of the Judges hut
- Assembly: 08:45 am followed by 45 minutes of official practice

Small trophies (rather than medals) will be awarded to first, second and third place
 However is dependent on entries per division

- Tents: are permitted and can be put up between 5-7 pm (only) on the day before the competition. Do not pitch over the # area. Overnight camping or practice is not permitted at this time.

- o **Toilets:** Male, female and disabled toilets are provided.
- Dogs: are permitted but must be kept on a lead at all times

- Music: will be played throughout the event
- Drug testing: World Record Status shoots are liable for drug testing and any competitors approached to give samples must comply. If they refuse, that refusal will be treated as a positive result. By entering an under 18 athlete, the parent (or guardian)confirms and accepts that they consent to their child being tested if approached.
