DRUG TESTING: record status shoots will be liable for drug testing and competitors approached to give samples must comply. If they refuse, that refusal will be treated as a positive result. Where an entry form contains one or more junior entries, the parent or guardian **must** countersign the form to signify that they consent to their child being tested if approached.

Anyone wishing to use video or photographic equipment at this tournament must register prior to the shoot.

Any children attending the tournament must have adult supervision.
